TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. **Academic Progress Requirement**: Scholars must maintain a **minimum grade point average** (6+ for GCSE or B for A Level) throughout the duration of the scholarship.
- 2. **Active Participation:** Scholars are encouraged to actively participate in extracurricular activities, leadership roles, community service, and events organized by the school.
- 3. **Professional Conduct**: Scholars must exhibit respectful behaviour, both within the school premises and in external environments, upholding the values and reputation of the institution.
- 4. **Personal Development:** Scholars are encouraged to engage in personal development initiatives such as workshops, seminars, and skill-building programs to enhance their holistic growth.
- 5. **Feedback and Improvement**: Scholars are encouraged to actively provide constructive feedback on the scholarship program, aiding in its continuous improvement.
